

Application Procedure Sixth Form (Years 12 and 13)

Sixth Form students follow a two-year GCE A Level and/or BTEC curriculum. Students can only be admitted into Sixth Form at the beginning of the academic year.

This application pack includes the application procedure, main application form, Sixth Form application sheet, a subject requirement information sheet and medical form.

COMPLETING THE APPLICATION FORM

• Please ensure that ALL sections of the application form are completed. Incomplete applications will not be processed.

• Payment and ALL supporting documents must be submitted at the time of application. This includes:

- □ Copy of applicant's passport
- Copy of Residence visa and Emirates ID (overseas students have 30 days from joining to submit)
- □ Most recent school report including last end of year report
- Actual or Predicted GCSE/IGCSE grades if transferring from a British curriculum school
- □ For students applying from other curricula, please provide a CAT4 report completed within the last <u>six months</u>, if available
- Completed sixth form application
- □ Completed medical form including immunisation records
- □ If applicable, any learning support reports, such as Individual Education Plans (IEPs) or external assessments
- Two passport photos
- □ AED 800 Application Fee
- Failure to disclose any relevant information may compromise your child's application.

INTERVIEW/ENTRY ASSSESSMENT

• Students coming from a British curriculum will be invited for an interview once all application documents have been received

• Students applying from other international curricula, will be required to sit an entrance assessment and attend an interview. If you are able to submit a CAT4 test report, which has been completed within the last six months, and entrance assessment may not be necessary.

OFFER LETTER

• Applicants will be placed on a waiting list if there are no places available at the time of application.

• Successful applicants will receive an offer letter and terms of acceptance by email. Offers for Sixth Form will be conditional upon achieving the required GCSE/IGCSE grades for the chosen A Level/BTEC subjects. To accept the place, you must return the terms of acceptance, accompanied by a non-refundable tuition fee deposit of AED 9,000. This will be deducted from the first term's tuition payment.

* The KHDA rules state that the residence visa copy from your child's passport must be submitted within 30 days of arriving in Dubai. This can be extended to 45 days but not beyond.

Students on a visit visa are not permitted to attend school. Their residence visa must be in process.

Transfer information from the applicant's previous school is required; this is done electronically, if moving from a school within Dubai. If applying from outside Dubai an attested transfer certificate is required for registration with the KHDA. Please refer to the sample letter in the information pack for countries that are exempt from attestation. If a child is starting mid-year a transfer certificate is required. The transfer certificate must be submitted on the student's first day of attendance. Registration with the KHDA will not be possible without these documents.

Sixth Form Subject Entry Requirements

A Levels

Since September 2015 A levels have been going through significant changes.

Most subjects have now moved to a new assessment structure where the AS qualification is no longer part of the final A Level grade (previously it counted as 50% of the final A Level grade).

In Year 12, you have two options: continue to the second year and go for the full A level or stop studying this subject and enter for the AS level qualification only.

Year 13; in the second year you deepen the knowledge you gained during your Year 12 course.

A levels are made up of separate units. These will be assessed by written exams, which take place in May & June, by coursework or practical examinations.

Most A Level students will choose to study FOUR subjects in Year 12. However, some students will then continue with THREE of these subjects in Year 13.

Students wishing to study the A-Level pathway must have at least 5 GCSEs level 5 or above as well as satisfying the subject minimum requirements.

Subjects available at A Level

Arabic, Art & Design, Biology, Business Studies, Chemistry, Computer Science, *Drama & Theatre Studies, Economics, English Literature, English Language & Literature, *Geography, Government & Politics, History, Mathematics, Mathematics, French, Spanish, Music, Physical Education, Physics, Psychology, Sociology

Subjects that are asterixed * are A Level courses only (unable to gain an AS) therefore run the full two years. Please consider this when making your choices.

BTECs

BTEC Nationals Level 3

BTEC Nationals are Level 3 (A Level equivalent) work-related qualifications. We offer a choice of 5 BTEC subjects:

Creative Media Production - 1 A level equivalent Science - can be studied as 1 A level equivalent Travel & Tourism - 1 A level equivalent Business - 1 A level equivalent

BTEC Nationals provide specialist, work-related learning, delivering the knowledge, skills and understanding students need to prepare for their chosen career. BTEC Nationals offer progression to higher education or directly into employment.

Units are assessed through coursework, both practical and written, some of which may be in controlled, timed conditions. Whilst completing units, students will receive a feedback and response opportunity to help them reach the highest levels.

It will be possible, for a student to study the smaller Diploma (12 unit) course with the addition of one or two AS courses in Year 12. Entry requirements for the AS course must be met.

Students wishing to study one of our BTEC courses will need a minimum of 5 GCSEs at level 4 or better.

Students should be aware that many courses which they may wish to take after completion of the BTEC could also require a level 5 in GCSE Maths and students will be encouraged to achieve this during year 12 if not attained in year 11.


Students choosing BTEC qualifications will be offered further advice and guidance before final choices have to be made.
