• Secondary students honored a long-standing tradition - Prank Day. It was well humoured and fun.

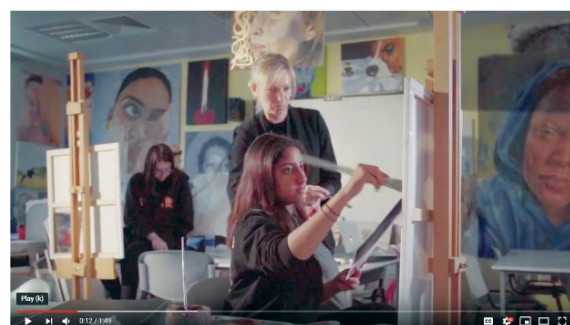
• Our students, parents and staff donated food to the Ramadan Fridges kept outside the school for the Holy month of Ramadan.
